

Rotary Club of Apopka Scholarship/Award Information

Student/Community Scholarships:

Dr. Harry Ansley RYLA (Rotary Youth Leadership Award) Scholarship-

A 4-day leadership training residential camp sponsored by local Rotary clubs. Students currently in 9th, 10th or 11th grade. Takes place during the spring semester Wednesday – Sunday. Nominations and applications available October 1 – December 1.

Graduating Senior Scholarships-

Rotary Club of Apopka Senior Award

Applications open January 1st annually and close March 15th. Open to graduating seniors in the greater Apopka area from Apopka High School, Wekiva High School, private school and home schools.

Interact Club Scholarship-

Applications open January 1st annually and close March 15th. Students must be a graduating senior and member of the Interact Club at either Apopka High School or Wekiva High School in good standing.

Roger Williams Apopka High Scholarship –

Award presented to the graduating senior from Apopka High School who exemplifies leadership traits and a commitment to community. Nominations and applications open January 1st annually and close March 15th.

Rotary Legacy Award-

Student must be a graduating senior of a current Rotary Club of Apopka members in good standing. Applications open January 1st annually and close March 15th.

Mayor John Land Community Award-

Community based grant available to local individuals, veterans, or students. Application period July 1 to June 30 annually. Grant form can be found at:

Graduating Senior Scholarships -

All applications must be sent to **PO Box 7, Apopka, FL 32704** and be received after **January 1st** and before **March 15th**. Individuals selected will be notified by email not later than **April 15th** and will have **14 days** to acknowledge receipt. Recipients will be invited, and must attend, as guests at a weekly meeting that is held on Thursdays with the Rotary Club of Apopka to formally accept the scholarship.

The scholarship will be awarded directly to the school you attend. We will verify enrollment. The awards will be up to \$1,000 each.

Requirements:

- Must be a citizen of the United States or Legal Resident.
- Must be a high school senior and residing in the Apopka area.
- Must attend an accredited College, University or Technical School.
- Provide two letters of recommendation from teachers, counselors, administrators, or business leaders.
- **Write an essay of not more than 300 words that explains your understanding of the Rotary Four Way Test and how you have incorporated it into your life.**
- List any leadership positions or participations in church, community or volunteer organizations and clubs at school you participate in.
- Tell us about your current job if you have one.
- List of all awards or honors received.
- Provide a fully completed Rotary Club of Apopka Scholarship Application Form by the deadline.
- Grade Point Average Minimum 2.5
